One of our users reported this error today, and indicated that it caused data loss. In this case, it was looking at the `babl_words_en_uk` dictionary (which is enabled, but I don't think she has that set as her language), and the Values in the error message were:

The error message was "Table '`xxxxx.babl_words_en_uk`' doesn't exist"

(The "`xxxxx`" above is potential site-identifying data.)
