LDAPv2 is obsolete, and the use of LDAPv3 is now standard practice. In fact, the latest releases of OpenLDAP don't even support LDAPv2 properly anymore. However, PHP's ldap\_connect() and PEAR::Auth default to LDAPv2.

The patch to use LDAPv3 is attached. It shouldn't be difficult to make the LDAP protocol version a configurable preference.
