- 1- edit a wiki page
- 2- click on the help button
- 3- scroll down to plugins
- 4- click on Activate/deactivate plugins which takes you to tiki-admin.php?page=textarea (wrong tab!)
- 5- Click on plugins
- 6- Activate a plugin
- 7- Notice that on next edit, the new plugin is not available
- 7a) a bug in my text, edit Help was in French, so maybe the cache of another user was appearing
