I ran phpinfo. We have PHP Version 5.2.9. We are running Fedora 10.

I made sure that php-xml was installed (it needed an upgrade).

The following command:

yum install php-dom

produces the same output as

yum install php-xml

i.e.

 $Package \ php-xml-5.2.9-2.fc10.x86_64 \ already \ installed \ and \ latest \ version$

Php info says the following:

 $libXML \ support \ active$

libXML Version 2.7.3 libXML streams enabled

I looked at http://php.net/dom and didn't see anything that was helpful like "install ..."

Is there a configuration flag that has to be set?
