Description

PECL's ssh2 extension is poorly maintained, hard to install and unreliable even when it has been successfully installed. Testament to just how difficult to install are all the comments located on the third website that comes up when you do a search for "php ssh" on Google (without the double quotes):

In light of this, I think TRIM ought to use phpseclib (http://phpseclib.sourceforge.net/). It would save everyone a lot of heartache, from the end users, who wouldn't need to ask for support, to the developers, who wouldn't have to spend as much time providing support for the deficiencies in PECL's ssh2 extension.

It would be good to hear from LPH on this matter since he is the author of TRIM.

I don't see a good reason to replace PECL's ssh2 extension with physeclib now. I don't think it is hard to install PECL's ssh2 (at least not on Ubuntu and ClearOS, in both distros all I had to do was install a package) and as far as I know we don't have reports of users having instability problems with TRIM. At least for TRIM PECL's ssh2 is working well.

In the future if we decide to add a significant amount of new features to TRIM it is worth revisiting this idea. It seems to me that physeclib has an easier API than PECL's ssh2.
