Description

This may be 2 bugs:

When you select Admin - External feeds and create a new feed, a blank page is presented after clicking "Save." It appears as though the external feed is saved, though.

Created feeds are not being updated on a schedule, nor are they being updated when the "Refresh" option is clicked. Clicking "Refresh" results in a blank page being displayed.

Workaround

This is not a bug. On CentOS 5, the php-xml package is required for this feature to work.

(Execute the command "yum install php-xml" at the command line, then "service httpd restart" to stop/start the Apache web server.)

Is the dom extension enabled? You can check phpinfo.

Looks like it's not: I see '--disable-dom' in the 'configure command' section. I also don't see a separate PHP "dom" RPM package to install for CentOS.

Just did some quick research. Seems like I need the php-xml package (there is also a php-xmlrpc package). Let me see if installing this package improves things.

Looks like for CentOS5, the php-xml package is also required (and a restart of httpd is required after installation).

It's working now - many, MANY thanks for all your help!

This should probably be reclassified as an enhancement request for a check for the required PHP feature during the installation process (certainly a documentation update that specifies the php-xml package as a requirement).
