Description

When I create a link to a Wiki page, the editor changes the reference of the link until the fourth time when I edit the page, but this is not a problem. The problem occurs when the link points to a wiki that has a special character, for example - **cabeçalho** - which means header (in Portuguese from Brazil), since the editor corrupts the link and it crashes.

Here I have an example.

The link should point to the wiki - Projeto de Pesquisa Social: Quem somos nós ? Proeja 2010 - is corrupted by the editor and points for -

Projeto+Pesquisa+Social:+Quem+somos+n%C3%83%C3%83%C3%83%C3%83%C3%83%C3%82%C2%B3s?+Proeja+2010 -

Using a Sniffer and following the transações in SQL, I discovered that the problem is located in the function toHtmlFormat on the editor.

Well, not sure if this function is part of the editor, but this information out of a package indicates where is the problem:

The text of the link points to the right place at the package and in MySQL, but it is broken when viewed in the editor.
