Description

Working with tracker items it is not possible to upload/select a file using using Files field type for trackers.

The file gets uploaded to the file gallery, but the modal closes without linking the file to the tracker item.

Solution

(Not sure offhand which commit did it but) selecting the file to upload no longer causes the edit-item modal to close, so files can successfully be added to a tracker item.

Just want to clarify that I'm able to attach files after an item is created in Tracker by going to the attachment tab. I just cannot upload any file, using the Attachment field, at the same time an item is being created.

Hi newbie01, this bug is about the Files field, rather than the deprecated "attach files" feature on a whole tracker. Also i'm afraid it's unlikely to get fixed in 13 now, 14.0 should be released tomorrow (at last!).

I have a feeling these issues (including yours) might be a server setup thing?

p.s. Just tried this again in several ways and it worked ok each time again... so cannot fix.
