Okay, so I discovered the issue with my calendars. It turns out that it is not a regression, and was in fact caused by an input to one of the calendar items from one of our users. Essentially, they were attempting to add an image to a calendar event, and instead of using the syntax that the 'Image' button uses, they did some sort of copy/paste using the wiki syntax.

Their input in the database looked like:

But the correct syntax looks like:



After hunting down the bug, it was determined to be the cause of our calendars getting hung during the loading screen, and resulted in the WSOD. After simply deleting these two entries from our database, the entire issue has been resolved.

Hopefully, there will be a way to restrict this from happening, as it took a couple of weeks to hunt this bug down, considering we had no idea when or where it originated from.

Since this issue has been resolved, this bug report can go ahead and be closed. Thanks!
