Description

The business theme has a monochrome grey/white background showing a plant. Usually the grey is as large as the content, but this is not the case for some wiki pages in branch 15.x as of r60042, as can be seen in the attached screenshot. This can be trivially reproduced with the "Test" page created by the collaborative community profile, or with a page which simply contains "foo".

While this may have no functional impact, I consider the impact on the look as a show-stopper. The icons top right (such as for editing) can display outside the background.

This would not happen in 12.x. This persists in trunk. It happens in 2 browsers on 2 tested (Iceweasel and Chromium).

Solution

To work well in all browsers and all page sizes, a new method for the background image is now used: one wide image that doesn't repeat (the "leaves" appear once at the top right of the column). The fix has been committed for trunk and branches 15 and 16 in r60046, 60047, 60048 and 60049.

Workaround

I wonder if this problem is specific to a browser or OS. In Windows (and Firefox, Chrome, etc.), the background image looks the same in Tiki 12 and 15, and goes the full width of the column (the CSS "background-size: contain" is used, but could be replaced by "background-size: 100% auto" if "contain" isn't supported in all browsers).

This affects Firefox 45.4.0, Konqueror 4.14.1 and Chromium 53.0 on Debian 8.6, and MSIE 11 on Windows 10.

Strange, IE11 on Windows 10 seems ok here. I toggled the background size rule in the DOM inspector and found that "background-size: contain" is supported by this browser. I wonder why it's different for you? I don't have Debian to test with, though, but made some screenshots at browsershots.com. Maybe there are some differences due to OS version or something. Chrome seems ok, but Konqueror doesn't seem to show the background image at all. I'll attach the images. Firefox didn't load in time for a complete

screenshot.

I see now, thanks. Newer Tiki versions use "background-size: contain" which works ok when there's enough content in the middle column to scale the image up to cover the column width. I didn't see the problem even with only wiki content of "foo" because I had a page-bottom module and other things that increased the column height.

In Tiki 12, the Business theme background image just repeats to fill the column. I don't recall if it was the same in older Tiki versions. But this doesn't seem very elegant to me. I think having the leaves appearing just once at the top right of the column would be best, with the gray gradient continuing to the left in the column. Probably a new image needs to be made, for the best solution (added to todo list ;-).
