"No route found. Please see <http://dev.tiki.org/URL+Rewriting+Revamp>" is triggered.

For example, if I have a wiki page with three external links and I put another one, then the error is triggered.

I have seen than the erros comes from "route.php" file.

I have rename the file \_htaccess to .htaccess.

I have verified that this error appears when I work from the web server, but it does not appear if I work on a local apache server (wamp).
