Description

On https://tiki.org/tiki-admin.php?page=intertiki#contentadmin_interwiki-2 when new records need to be added it does not save the item when "Apply" button is clicked. It just reloads the page.

Reproduced on show: Login as admin 12345

Then try to add a new entry like this: nexttest ABC123 127.0.0.2 test

It will fail silently (because it contains "ABC123" for the key which is already there) just reloading the page without adding new entry.

It would be useful for pre-dogfood servers (next*.tiki.org sites) to allow entries with the same key as in the past so the sites would not need different unique key manually added on each db re-import. But mainly it should at least give some error feedback!

There is no last entry named "test" in the "Allowed client servers". Last entry I see is "profiles.tw.o". And my "nextthemes" did not save either.

Aaaaaaaaaaaaaaaaaaaaaaa, I think I understand what the problem is now!

The Key must be unique! If it is not the new entry does not get saved without any error feedback message at all!

It worked with same keys in the past though apparently, as there are entries with same key already recorded. Just new ones cannot be added now with silent fail.
