after launching Configuration wizard (clean 18.2 installation) to apply some profile, I notice that the Featured Site Configurations is rendered poorly with Firefox 61 (running Debian Sid x86_64 linux), although it renders properly with e.g. Chromium 66.

Thanks for reporting this problem. I found some nonstandard layout practices in the configuration wizard files and corrected these in Subversion commit r67129, submitted just now. These corrections will show up in the next release of Tiki 18. The problems were kind of edge case so depended on how different browsers dealt with them. I didn't notice any problem when testing originally, but I don't have a Linux environment to test in, so didn't see the problem as you reported.

Interestingly, the trunk (to be released as Tiki 19) configuration wizard page looks almost exactly like the screenshot of the broken Tiki 18 page, but I'm working on fixing these pages now.
