# Description

When *Automatic indexing of file content* is active, trying to upload pdf files fails.

The pdf file is still uploaded but the end user is told that upload failed.

http://nycdwight-11908-6600.show.tikiwiki.org/tiki-upload\_file.php?galleryId=4! (beware of the 8MB size limit) (verify that *Automatic indexing of file content* is still active)

They display an error « File upload failed: SyntaxError: JSON.parse: unexpected character at line 1 column 1 of the JSON data ».

Only for pdfs.

The issue seems to be one or more invisible BOM (zero-length nonbreaking spaces) character before the json string.

My guess is, this regression is related to our changing the way pdfs are indexed. Since Tiki18, we use a php library bundled with Tiki. Before, we relied on a command line executable. Sadly, reverting to the old way of putting the following in tiki-admin.php?page=fgal#contentfgal admin-5 does not work:
