Description

The German localization breaks the layout of the calendar list list mode. If an event spans several days, and each of those days are entirely covered "whole day" calender obviously introduces the text "whole day" in that. But in the German localization it reads "den ganzen Tag" which is considerably longer in pixels than "whole day", and thus breaks the layout, overwriting the finishing date of the event.

Either the localization has to be abbreviated, or the layout should adapt to the rendered length of the text in pixels...

Not really an important bug, but looks really awful...

Contribution isn't as easy as shown in the video. If interactive translation is on, clicking on Control Panel simply leads to the translation of Control Panel (which is logical), if it is off, you get the error message that you don't have administrative rights...

Oh, and while we're at it. Because I thought maybe the same steps should be done on one's own site (which is not the case) I tried the built-in i18n, custom translation.

That yields the error message "Custom translation file does not exist. Save a custom translation to create the file. ". If you enter a translation and click on Save, you just get the same error message again, and your entry is simply lost. That's on 18.5. Sigh, yet another bug. Being admin I should have all necessary rights to create that file...

There are more localization issues with Calendar: The mouseover text of the left and right arrows, to go the the previous week and next week are labelled in English, despite the fact that the Wiki is set to German.

Also, those arrows are only visible when the module calendar\_new is set to show "partial" navigation.

On the default navigation settings, the left arrow is almost outside the browser window, just 2 pixels of the arrow remain inside, and the right arrow overlaps into the central content division.

One more on the localization: I do not know what the English text for this is, in the German localized version when you create a repeated event, you are being asked a number, and that dialog is labelled "Häufigkeit", which is "frequency" in English. But I guess what is really being asked for is the number of repetitions, and that would be "Wiederholungen" in German. And as I wrote in my feature request, I miss either a checkbox "endless" ("endlos" in German) or the acceptance of a 0 for endless.

Still getting worse, when you though it couldn't possibly become worse. Calendar is completely useless. Look at the next two screenshots. In list view, the main window looks decent and fully usable, but look at the module in the left zone! In calendar view mode, the module looks nice and decent, but the main window is useless...

And when you click on an event in list mode, the layout once again gets broken: The left module zone vanishes, and the right module zone is displayed below (!) the central (!) part...

When hovering over a date with event(s), the localizations displays a mouseover. If there are two or

more events, the mouseover reads "2 Ereignissen". That's the wrong grammatical case, it should be nominative "2 Ereignisse".

Also, if the module is set to display "partial" navigation, there is no way to return to the current week (at the moment I have week display). The module always shows whatever you last selected in either the module or in the main window, but there is no button to return to today, and navigating backwards can be tiresome, if previously you looked at an event in the farer future...
