

## Translate mods

Since Tiki 8.x translations for mods should be distributed with the mod itself (instead of placed inside lang/xx/language.php files). The mod should have a lang directory with one directory per language code (following the same structure Tiki uses).

But instead of calling the files language.php they should be called language\_modName.php. So for example for the plugin R mod the file should be called language\_r.php.

The script get\_strings.php can help you to collect strings from your mod source code. But you first need to manually create the language file for each language you want to support (you can create an empty file).

To collect strings from your mod source files to language files run (from a Tiki root dir):

```
php get_strings.php lang=xx baseDir=pathToModDirOutsideTikiInstallation fileName=languageFileName
```

If you were doing this for plugin R mod and Catalan language:

```
php get_strings.php lang=ca baseDir=pathToModDirOutsideTikiInstallation fileName=language_r.php
```

After running the script, it is important that you rename the array inside language files from \$lang to \$lang\_mod. If you fail to do this, your mod translations will override all other Tiki translations.
