I've installed a new Tikiwiki at <http://www.vic-fontaine.com/forum> and started configuring it.

Now I have the following: No-one can log in any longer.

Steps to reproduce (at my installation):

- Create new user
- Confirm e-mail
- Log out new user

> Login not possible

Admin can't log in either. I've managed to reset admin password to "admin". Still can't log in.

I've posted a questin in the forum, but now I believe this really is a bug. If you need more information about my installation, I can give it to you (database entries etc.)

Please feel free to log into my installation as admin if you manage to.

Solution

This appears to be the challenge/response feature.

update tiki_preferences set value = 'n' where name='feature_challenge'; might workaround.

I had something similar happen. I went into the users_users table and set "valid" to NULL. Then I turned off the admin and email validation. Log in is now working again.

See if that doesn't do it for you as well. Once you get your users logging in again, then you can turn the validation back on. Use their user name to send them a "reset password" from the log in screen.
