Description

I discovered a problem where one of our users had created a page containing the words SeaMonkey in the description. When she later tried to link to this page with the syntax **This is the link text**, the link broke, and tried to embed a link to create a new page titled SeaMonkey among other things. The cause of the problem, was that the description of the page she linked to, was inserted as the title of the <a>-tag.

Solution

Make sure that the description is not parsed as wiki dialect.
