Description

Tested when generating webhelp from a wiki structure...

With the "best language" feature enabled, Tiki will generate wiki links with the &bl=y suffix. When converted to webhelp, Tiki does not remove this link suffix.

As a result, HTML links includes this suffix. For example: foo&bl=y.html

This is incorrect — the link should simply be: foo.html

Solution

Tiki should generate html links ONLY with the filename.
