Description

The confirmation message for new users has an incorrect order of headers. With cpanel hosting, this is not being recognised as a valid e-mail:

To quote RFC822 (amazing it still defines smtp email and it was passed in 1982)

"Due to an artifact of the notational conventions, the syntax indicates that, when present, some fields, must be in a particular order. Header fields are NOT required to occur in any particular order, except that the message body must occur AFTER the headers. It is recommended that, if present, headers be sent in the order "Return- Path", "Received", "Date", "From", "Subject", "Sender", "To", "cc", etc.

So its not a rule that FROM: come before TO: but it is a recommendation
