Description

When you create an article and try to give formatting to it it puts weird symbols. For example, for bold, instead of putting a word bold it puts weird symbols around the word.

When you are trying to add a file to the article, so the reader can download it with a click, or when you want to add a link or if you want to add an image; all this buttons do not work.

I've installed 7.x (JumpBox version) after using several earlier versions for the past 2 years. I am now unable to edit properly — WYSIWYG functions might look okay in the editing window, but the actual text, whether saved or in preview, contains formatting codes. This is showing up primarily in articles, but also at least one Wiki page of long-standing has been completely destroyed — all users can see is a bunch of worthless formatting codes. I've had a hard enough time with users in my company adopting the Wiki. Now all they see is crapped out articles and a crapped out page. I have tried stripping the formatting codes out and pasting in the text, but the PASTE from WORD feature seems broken. Even when I paste as plain text, the text is magically transformed into something like this:

I can't even format it properly using wiki syntax. Absolutely unusable.
