### Description

I have the following problem:

we wanted to upgrade our old tiki 2.2 to the new tiki 4.0 but there are some problems.

after using tiki-install.php to upgrade the old tiki to the new one the image galleries doesn't work anymore, even though it is activated in the features menu.

the problem is the following:

every time i want to go to tiki-galleries.php i get the following error:

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the problem is as you see there is no error message only the query is displayed.

i tried to install a vanilla 4.0 and created two galleries where each of it has one image in it and it works fine

i compared the database tables tiki\_images, tiki\_images\_data and tiki\_galleries and they seem to have the same structure

i tried to copy the tables mentioned above from the upgraded tiki into a clean install and still get the error above

possible problem seems to be with the tiki\_image table as it works fine without the images in the image tables - but the error appears only after i copy the image tables into the database

it would be nice if someone could help me / fix this problem as it would take some time to reupload all the images (then probably into the file galleries)

and besides that is there a tool that moves the images from the image gallery to the file gallery for future use?

edit: all the other php files work like tiki-list\_gallery.php and tiki-browse\_gallery.php

#### Solution

The issue is fixed in svn in branch 4.x. To resolve the issue until the next Tiki 4.X version is released, download the files tiki-browse\_gallery.php and lib/imagegals/imagegallib.php from <http://tikiwiki.svn.sourceforge.net/viewvc/tikiwiki/branches/4.x/> and replace them.

I can see the galleries with tiki-browse\_gallery.php but not all of them

FWIW, I'm not storing my images in the database, but in the file system. Also, if I enter a link to edit one of the galleries, I get the same error as when I try to just list the galleries:

tiki-galleries.php?offset=0&sort\_mode=name\_asc&edit\_mode=1&galleryId=36. If I remove all the sorting info and leave just the galleryId, I still get the same error. This is now with v4.1, but I presume the same would have happened with v4.0.

I find it hard to believe that this problem isn't more widespread. Maybe we are unique?

Glad to find this bug reported - having the same problem with exactly the same type of error message.

For me it seems the error is triggered by having a parent directory. Changing the parentgallery field to -1 (ie, none) in the tiki\_galleries table seems to clear it up for me. Not sure if that's the case for others also.
