### Description

The inheritance of permissions between groups seems to be completely broken in trunk (r33152).

For example, when Registered includes the permissions of Anonymous, granting tiki\_p\_admin\_wiki to Anonymous should allow Registered to admin wiki pages, but that doesn't work. The same thing happens with tiki\_p\_view and tiki\_p\_read\_comments.
