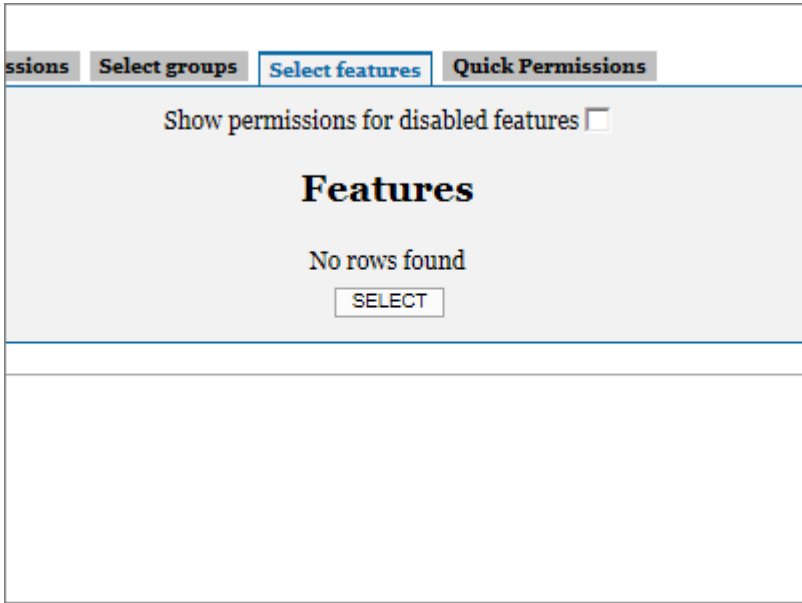

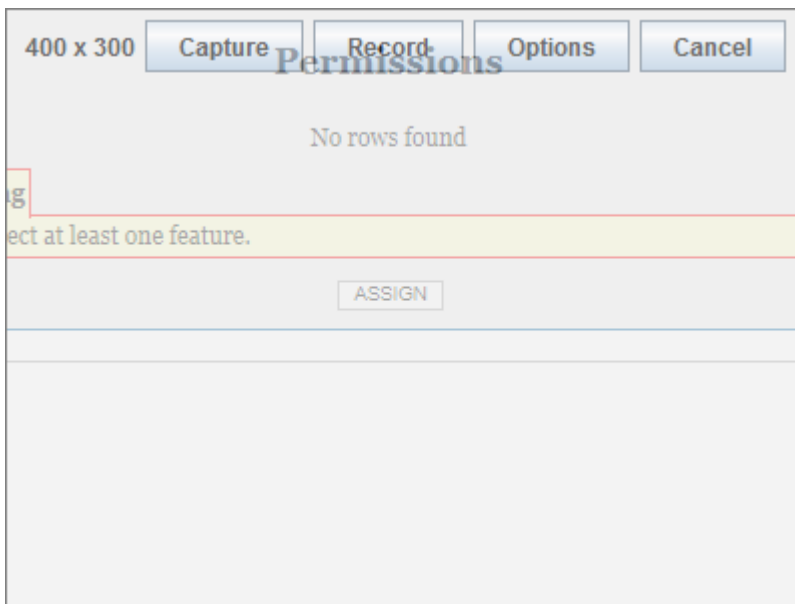
Description

Was using Tiki 6.x, backed up databases, did a fresh install of version 9, then upgraded to version 10.2, moved article database back. When I create a new article, then tried to assign object level

permissions.



The assign permissions area needs a feature selected (see



. When I go to Select Features, none of

the installed features show up. However I can check the box for "Show permissions for disabled features" the missing ones show up but still can't set the article permissions.

Not sure what the issue can be, I verified that Administrators have all the proper access. I can set global permission for the same "missing" features. Not sure what to do at this point.

I'm newbie to Tiki and setting up my first project last 2 Weeks.

Sometimes it's cruel for me and cost lot of time to search correct place for solving "simple" bugs.

The same behavior as you described to articles, related also to topics-permissions.

My opinion ... incorrect permType in templates.

Solved for me with some changes:

templates/tiki-admin_topics.tpl
templates/tiki_list_articles.tpl

Search for "permType=cms" and replace by permType=articles.

Also look at lib/tikilib.php, function get_permGroup_from_objectType, case 'articles' and replace return 'cms' by return 'articles'. Without this change, users can read the full article, although they only have the permission "tiki_p_articles_read_heading"

With the above changes, you should now assign permissions to articles and topics.

Caution: If you assign topic-permissions, you only need topic-permission OR article-permission to read. For my project doing any changes in lib/articles/artlib.php and now users need permissions to both objectTypes "topic" and "article" for read....
