Text mime parts of mail messages are initialized with an improper Content-Transfer-Encoding MIME header of 7bit instead of 8bit

Solution

In lib/webmail/htmlMimeMail.php
line 129
replace characters at position 43-57 '7bit'
with: 8bit

This fix the constructor class to proper sane default 8bit.
