Description

It appears that the email builder expects, but doesn't find: lib/core/Reports/Send/EmailBuilder/WikiPageCreated.php

I copied WikiPageChanged.php and made minimal changes (attached), and the next error was about wiki_page_deleted, so I copied & edited it again (attached), and the errors stopped.

I haven't yet just received Daily Report email to verify that everything works correctly, however.
