It links to tiki-list users.php.

When I click on this (fresh 12.x installation, user: admin), I am returned to the Tiki homepage.

Not sure what it should do, but if no users are found .. and that's the problem, it should give a message saying so.

It's not a bug, that functionality was removed when the "friendship network" was revamped and that page became redundant. It was changed to redirect to home instead of being deleted so as to not break upgraded sites where someone upgraded on top of a previous release (not recommended).
