Modules have a default width of 100%, and need a grid class to be assigned in order to be only part of the page's width. In the admin modules page, this can be set as the "containing class". For the menu and search form in the topbar module zone, these can be "col-md-9" for the menu module and "col-md-3" for the search form.

In fresh installs, I guess these module parameters are provided by the setup; for upgraded sites, probably admins will have to assign the module parameters manually.
