### Description

Plugin TrackerIf doesn't seem to accept nesting so far, and we need it to allow customization of the interface to edit data with Pretty Trackers.

- If field\_1 is A
  - if field\_2 is not empty, display value of field\_2
  - if field\_3 is not empty, display value of field\_3
  - if field\_4 is not empty, display value of field\_4
  - ...
- if field\_1 is B
  - if field\_10 is not empty, display value of field\_10
  - if field\_11 is not empty, display value of field\_11
  - if field\_12 is not empty, display value of field\_12
  - ...

Workaround

Workarounds:

- use <https://doc.tiki.org/PluginTrackerToggle> to display the first section only when f\_1='A', etc.
  - It does work properly when the value to be tested is '0' (zero).
- use <https://doc.tiki.org/PluginTrackerItemField> to display the first section only when f\_1='A', etc.
  - It does NOT work properly when the value to be tested is '0' (zero). It displays the content even if the value of the field is NOT zero.

I think this issue is with all these types of plugins having an {ELSE} part. The problem is with parsing the ELSE. It catches the first ELSE and the parser thinks it belongs to the first plugin in the set (the top parent) of nested plugins using it, not the nested one to which it actually belongs...
