I think... Thanks, so it will still work if the namespace_separator is set to something like "~"? (sorry, the code looked like it was splitting at colon chars, i didn't test it... 3)

Yes, it will still work, if you set other namespace separator. I have tested.

Because the problem is caused by the object selector:

e.g: <option value="wiki page:TEST:_:Page">TEST:_:Page</option>

The js function get this value. Firstly split at ':' character, and you get an array.

The first element is the type, but the other elements contains the page name. If the page's name don't contains ':' you get the full name in the second element of array. (id = val.split(':')1;)

Otherwise you get more than 2 elements, so you have to concatenate to get the full name.
