I always do this by using plugin list and a "pretty tracker" template, it's a rather involved and long topic but you can probably get started by looking at the examples on LIST - advanced output command

The basic idea is you have one wiki page with the list plugin in, using a parameter on the url for the itemId which picks the tracker item you want to get the data from, and the template then lays it out according to your design...

Is that enough to get you started?
