Description

After placing a working H5P plugin on a wiki page, an edit button will appear directly below the H5P content for admins. This is similar to what appears when displaying the H5P content from the File Gallery, where it brings up the correct dialog for editing the H5P content.

However, on the wiki page, the edit button links to 'tiki-editpage.php' instead of 'tiki-ajax_services.php'. This causes the ajax popup to show the wiki page edit dialog, instead of the controller dialog. Using Chrome, I was able to test this, and the one change in the href field was able to pull up the correct dialog.

I am not able to create a show.t.o instance right now, but will create one ASAP.

If I were to hazard a guess, the issue would be in /lib/wiki-plugins/wikiplugin_h5p.php

Solution

This seems fine for me in both 19.x and 18.x so maybe this one just went away? (if i'm checking the right thing)

Nope (opens last referrer in the modal instead of the correct one for me), see my comment below.

Hopefully 68813 fixes it. (fingers crossed)

Workaround

Comment out line 198 in lib/smarty_tiki/function.query.php

The bug is still there. What it does is it replaces the correct link to `tiki-ajax_services.php` with any referrer you visited just before accessing the page with the H5P plugin. Maybe you Jonny were "lucky" and accessed the wiki page just after visiting the `tiki-ajax_services.php` so it was replaced with the same. Or you use SEFURLs in your testing environment. The problematic line lies in the `lib/smarty_tiki/function.query.php`, line 198:



```

When I commented out that line everything still seems to work flawlessly but I'm unsure if it might be there still something in Tiki relying on it.
