Hello all!

I have a Tiki instance, installed with regular Apache and .htaccess and I tried to put the Ngnix as a reverse proxy for that.

The Nginx was setup to accept just https connections. The scheme is forwarded by using the header X-Forwarded-Proto, which is suggested by nginx documentation. While Tiki does not recognize that, Tiki pages will use the regular <a href="http">http</a> when rendering action on any form, like auth form for example. When user POST to <a href="http://">http://</a>, the proxy will redirect <a href="http://">https://</a>, the proxy will redirect <a href="http://">https://</a>, the proxy will redirect <a href="http://">https://</a>, the proxy will redirect <a href="http://">https://</a>

I suggest Tiki recognize X-Forwarded-\* and also Forwarded, as we can find on https://www.nginx.com/resources/wiki/start/topics/examples/forwarded/.
