Description

In my 19.2 (svn) it appears the H5P application is working beautifully, at first. I can initiate an application, edit it, upload images to the application, but when it comes time to save the application and display it, the images do not appear. If I go back to the application and edit it, the images have dissappeared.

~~This may be unique to my own installation of tiki, I will create a show instance here, and see if it is only my installation, or if it truly is a bug.~~ I reproduced it on my own Tiki.

Solution

At the first save time the images need to be moved/copied from `storage/public/h5p/editor/images/` to `storage/public/h5p/content/XY/images/` where XY is a number (should be a newly created dir) as the created H5P type is looking for them there for

displaying and/or editing.

Workaround

If you save the H5P object first, you need to edit it, re-upload the images and after another save it finally works.

I just did some upgrades and fixes for H5P in branch 22.x and trunk - if they seem good i'll backport them all to 21.x, hopefully the various issues regarding uploading files are now resolved (there was quite a lot of code missing!)

Tests done. My conclusion is (see the solution field for TL;DR version):

There is definitely a bug I reproduced on my own copy too. When creating a new H5P object which needs user to upload images it first uploads them to `storage/public/h5p/editor/images/` and they are visible after upload in the editor (you can check by right click the preview and open the image in new browser window). But after save they are not copied or moved to the right location from there, which should be `storage/public/h5p/content/XY/images/` (again you can right click the broken image and check the dir `XY` (which is a number) was not created and the image was not moved there.)

When you try to edit that H5P object it tries to load the images from the same new "display" location, not from the editor one anymore as when you were creating it and uploading the images there, so again it appears as if the uploaded images were gone (it never looks to the `storage/public/h5p/editor/images/` so it appears as if the images were missing even after re-uploading them unless you save the H5P object and then they finally get copied to the correct place and "magically" appear).

Hi, I had the chance to have a look today. It seems that you created a show instance last july based on tiki 20.x. By then,there was some problem (internal to tiki's code base) which didn't allow composer to suceed fetching packages needed for tiki to work.

I've updated that instance, avoided then the issue with composer 2 not working, but I since there was no database created in july, I opted to remove the whole 20.x show2.tiki.org instace linked to this report, and I was aiming to create a brand new one based on Tiki 22.

For some reason, Tiki 22 is still not offered through the bug tracker field options for end users, even if the show2.tiki.org infrastructure seems ready to serve this version. We might be missing some minor tweak somewhere (sorry for that).

On the other hand, I've gladly seen that you seem to have created a show2.t.o instance based on trunk for this tracker item, and that worked as expected, as far as I could see (great!)

Oh well, thanks for your patience, and for energy and good will you add to the Tiki Community, John.

"Future Scope: Remove the feature entirely (replacing the deprecation warning with a compiler error) in PHP 8 or another future release."
