templates/tiki-admin menu options.tpl

from the repo but it will only show a white page.

I cannot create a show2-instance here that is working, error message:

"Tiki Installer missing third party software files. Your Tiki is not completely installed because Composer has not been run to fetch package dependencies. You need to run sh setup.sh from the command line." I guess it's because I did not create the tracker item.
