In this file I cannot find any localization tr() or tr in curly braces at all, thus all texts displayed like "Time" "Hour" and "Minute" are translated in no local language at all...

Added a screenshot (attachment) to show the date picker. Strangely the month does translate (Juli instead of July), as do the two buttons underneath. Heute and Ok for Today and done.

Even more strange is the button "Show duration", which comes not come from the jquery script, but from the Tiki template file tiki-calendar_edit_item.php. When the page is loaded for the first time, the button (which flips back and forth between Show duration and Show end time) gets translated. But once flipped, the button reverts to English and stays English no matter how often you look at it.
