Hi hman,

that happened to me frequently for several years after nearly every second installation. However in my case that was in 100% of the cases an error_40 which I could resolve after getting a cup of coffee or some sleep in only few seconds - please confirm that you found a new bug.

Please first try to set the new setting as default setting before reloading or leaving the page!

=> The slider button is not enough (slide=step1/2); new setting must be confirmed (confirm=step2/2)

Please test!

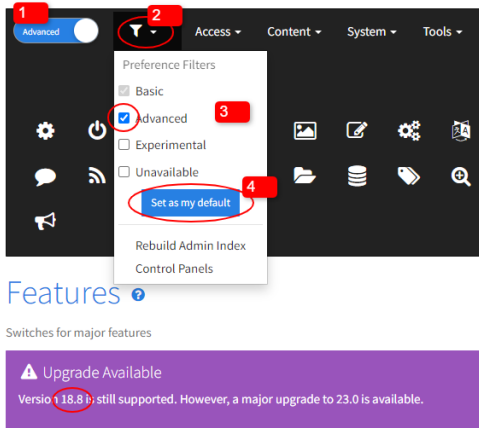
