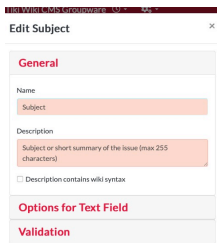
### Description

There are several cases an Admin want to use the login module but need to add some informations. To solve this it is possible to use the module in a page or in another module. This is not very intuitive and require editing work.

Adding a "free text" field will make much easier to add login or registration information (or whatever want the admin/editor).

### Solution

Add a new field "Description (optional - it will be displayed above the form fields)".  
Add an option "Description contains wiki syntax" (a checkbox) similar to what we have in tracker fields



Based on the screenshot

If the field is empty, nothing change

If the field is not empty and the wiki syntax checkbox is not checked the value is added just above the field "username". (text)

A Wiki syntax checkbox will be great and we have already such mechanism. (tracker field description, menus items, modules, etc...)

Because this may turn into a pandora box (one can use HTML plugin + DIV + List plugin), with an option, there is more acceptance of responsibilities and understanding that "you", the user, is acting on something. (I don't know a way to "limit" the wiki syntax)

We can add a tooltip to warn unpredictability.

I fear people trying foolish things (registration page or tracker registration within... infinite loop ?).

If it is easy to do (like our tracker description) I propose we do the Wiki syntax (optional) we can always test a bit and evaluate.

If too dangerous we remove the wiki syntax option.

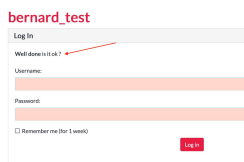
as suggested by bernard i studied the function of the wiki syntax activation on the trackers. i saw that the checkbox is in fact just a field that is stored in the database. on display if this field is positive then it will call the wiki tag. so the solution becomes a little simpler. i will replace the `<p></p>` tags by `{wiki}{/wiki}`. so when the text has elements of the wiki syntax it will display them and if nothing is included in the string it will not display anything. I don't apply the same shema as for the trackers because the tiki\_preferences table doesn't provide additional fields to add other elements that would allow to do the test.
