On a Tiki24 I set up multilingual, I setup a tracker with a few multilingual fields. (tracker field option)



I add items and fill some multilingual fields.

Then, I disable multilingual.

When I go to the fields options, the multilingual checkbox is not displayed anymore. (good)



When I go in the tracker interface to view items, the other language fields values are displayed. (weird... but do we allow loss of data?)

When I go in the tracker interface to create a new item, the other language fields values are displayed. (wrong)

When I look at a wiki-plugin tracker the other language fields values are displayed. (wrong)

Ok I found the issue I can't fix that.

The value for the field multilingual (the checkbox) is still set even if we don't see it.



'isMultilingual' => string 'y' (length=1)

We need a mechanism that nullify this value (any field) is the Tiki multilingual feature is turned off. I think the closest to the fields settings the better.

Nullifying in each template look to me like a cheap solution.

Example, at templates/trackerinput/layout_flat.tpl somewhere in the foreach. $\{if !\$ {\field.isMultilingual=''} \{/if\}
