### Description

hman is likely the most prolific issue reporter on dev.tiki.org of recent years. He does very thorough testing and provides detailed issue reports. However, he is doing this on older versions of Tiki, which are in security-fixes only phases.

Sometimes, the issue is already fixed in a subsequent version. Sometimes, not. If we knew this, it would save everyone a lot of time.

If hman could set up next servers, he could easily see if a specific issue is this visible in trunk, 24x, etc.

I repeat, I AM willing to provide testing. But I am unable.

I am not responsible for getting stuck at version 18. Tiki went incompatible to itself, which IMHO is the worst possible decision that could have been made. My testing is an output generated by me using Tiki on two productive sites.

I cannot upgrade beyond 18, and 18 will come to an end, as it does not support current PHP. Using non-current versions of PHP increases the monthly cost of running Tiki, and since both my Tikis are essentially non-profit, this limits the lifetime of the installations...
