I had this exact issue today on my tikiwiki install. And if anyone is interested, I was able to pinpoint this issue to chosenGroup variable in the registration parameters.

In tiki24.3 the register_new_user_local() function in "lib/registration/registrationlib.php" calls the add_user() function from userslib.php which has the optional variable "\$groups".

In tiki 21 this variable was not passed along from this function in registrationlib.php. In tiki24 it is and it is [registration['chosenGroup']]. It is not checked if the variable registration['chosenGroup'] was actually set (with the php isset() function).

Instead of an empty array [], this now passes an array with a single element ["]. Inside userslib.php the add user() group now enters a foreach loop, that fails when trying to add the new user to group ".

I added a workaround in my local tikiwiki 24.3 site by patching the following 2 lines
