permName=tiki_p_search

set admin to n

This line in db/tiki.sql was wrong

```
INSERT INTO users_permissions (permName, permDesc, level, type, admin) VALUES ('tiki_p_search',  
'Can search', 'basic', 'tiki', 'y');
```

should be

```
INSERT INTO users_permissions (permName, permDesc, level, type) VALUES ('tiki_p_search', 'Can  
search', 'basic', 'tiki');
```
