To reproduce:

1. Get a fresh install
2. Visit tiki-admin.php?page=trackers
3. Activate "Trackers" but nothing else
4. Notice tracker_insert_allowed being activated without being checked

Another is: user_trackersync_trackers in tiki-admin.php?page=login

So please, on a fresh install of 12.x, go through each admin panel and activate or deactivate the 1st available checkbox, and check if other prefs are turned on or off, and please resolve them.

Please do these fixes in 12.x unless you think they are risky, in which case trunk or ask for help.
