Looks like something is not doing that anymore. Ideally we want buttons like in Gogole and Microsoft Word to inject a tab which creates 2nd level.

Not sure what the expected behaviour should be for this, as it's two types of list mixed up isn't it? A # starts an ordered list (ol) but \* is for unordered lists (ul), so either the second line should start ## or the first one should start with an \*. Check the html the parser produces on a normal wiki page to see what i mean?

Regarding the increase/decrease indent buttons that do this in html mode they do list indenting (which is supported by wiki syntax), but also paragraph indenting (which isn't), so they would cause other issues if those buttons were shown for wiki-mode wysiwyg.

I can confirm that for me (with properly formed lists) the tab and shift+tab keys do indent/outdent the list items.
